

Wrestling: Lewisville competes in 6-way dual at Keller

Dylan Herlehy, Michael McClure and Michael McKinney each won four of five matches Saturday competing at the Keller 6-Way Duals to lead Lewisville's wrestling team to a 3-2 finish.

The Farmers were competing against tough competition, including area-power Lake Highlands as well as 6-5A foe Marcus in addition to Keller, Keller Central and Arlington Heights.

"I thought it went pretty well for our first match," said Kent Hall, Lewisville coach. "We barely won a match against Lake Highlands and I was pretty disappointed we lost against Marcus. But overall it went well."

Herlehy wrestled at 215 pounds, while McClure competed at 171 and McKinney 160.

Michael's brother, Conner McKinney, also performed well, taking three of four duals at 160.

Clay Lewis (135), Ryan Hamilton (180), Rey Martinez (125) and Eddie Martin (119) each went 3-2 at the meet.

Other competitors for the Farmers were Eduardo De La Sancha (145), who Hall said gave a great effort, as well as Eric Polanco (130), James Ledger (140) and James Leininger (112).
